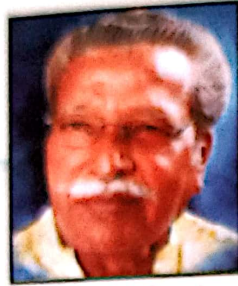

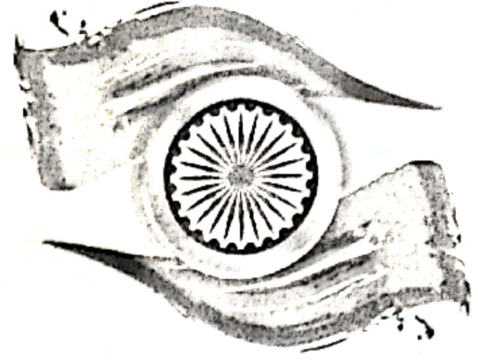

The great philanthropist, Late Smt Krishnabai Sarada donated her 200 acres of land to Shri Sarada Education Society in 1916, paving the way for higher education in this area.

Smt Radhabai Sarada Arts, Commerce & Science College was established in the year 1966 by Shri Sarada Education Society under the guidance of a great visionary-educationist, Late Dadasaheb Kalmegh, former Vice-Chancellor of Nagpur University. Later, the college began its journey under the able leadership of Shri Nandkishorji Sarada, the founder President and Dr Rameshchandraji Sarada, the founder Secretary. The sole aim of Shri Sarada Education Society is to impart need based quality education to the residents of Anjangaon Surji and its adjacent area.

At present, the college is running undergraduate courses in three faculties i.e. BA, BCom & BSc along with postgraduate courses in three subjects i.e. English, Marathi and Home-Economics. The subjects like Marathi and English Literature in BA and MA are developing artistic, aesthetic, creative, social and moral sensibility among the students. With the new B VOC courses in the offering the College has 7 Research Centres wherefrom more about 50 students have been awarded their Ph D degree. A total of 16 Research Guides are helping more Ph D scholars to pursue for their degrees.

The college has Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University distance education center for BA, BCom and MCom courses, offering an opportunity to around 2000 students every year.

The college makes the optimum use of the ICT facilities, a large campus, a state-of-art-playgrounds and a rich library with more than 38000 books & more than 6 lakhs e-books.

Admission Procedure

1. Admissions to FYBA/ BCom/ BSc shall be strictly on merit basis. Application for admission to the college should be made on the prescribed online admission form available on the college website by the students including those studying in the same college during the previous year. Students should apply immediately after the declaration of the results of the pertinent examination of the previous year.
2. The students should fill in the online admission form and submit the print outs to the admission committee.
3. The admission form duly completed in all respects and accompanied by requisite documents should be submitted to the college on or before the last date notified by the college. The list of requisite documents to be attached to the admission form is given in the next section. The admission forms which are incomplete or incorrectly filled or submitted late will be summarily rejected.
4. The admission form signed by the admission committee should be submitted to the college office on the same day.
5. The reservation policy shall be in accordance with the norms and guidelines laid by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
6. The admission granted by the college is provisional until it is confirmed by the University.
7. The admission in case of FY BA/MA-I/ B VOC/ Jr, Arts & Jr Science / HSC Vocational shall be given on first come first serve basis.

Discipline and Code of Conduct

Discipline :

1. Self discipline is the best discipline. All students are expected to observe the rules and regulations currently in force to enable smooth working of the college.
2. Students are prohibited to perform any act inside or outside the college that may interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image. No outside influence, political or any other, should be brought into the college directly or indirectly.
3. Students resorting to the unfair means at the examination will be dealt in accordance with the Maharashtra University Act 2016.
4. Fines shall be charged in accordance with the rules and regulations of SGBAU, the Govt. of Maharashtra and UGC.
5. The details of the uniform as finalized by the college are given below :

For Girls : Sky Blue Kurta, Navy Blue Salwar & Dupatta.

7. Students' Development Cell as has been formed in the college by the notification No. SGBAU - 13/47/2019

Code of Conduct :

1. Students should always carry their valid college identity card in the college or whenever representing the college at any other place. Further it should be produced whenever demanded by anyone of the college staff.
2. During the lectures, students should not loiter in and around college premises.
3. Students are directed not to accompany any outsider in the college premises.
4. While representing the college at any other place, the students should not act in the manner to harm the image of the college.
5. Students should not collect any funds from the fellow students or from the outsiders without the written permission of the Principal.
6. Students shall not organize picnics, excursion, trips etc. on their own without prior written permission of the Principal.
7. The authority relating to the disciplinary action in the college will rest with the Principal and his decision in this respect shall be final. Anyone who violates the code of conduct will be severely dealt with accordingly.
8. The college has a dress code. All students are expected to observe the decorum with regards to both clothing and behavior.
9. Ragging is prohibited by the Government of India and notified ragging as a cognizable offence. Any one reported to be involved in any form of ragging will be severely dealt with.

10. UGC Letter No. f 1-8-2006 (CPP-II), dated Feb. 08, issues the following Supreme Court of India Orders if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the student concerned shall be given liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him from the institution.
11. Using Mobile is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
12. Wearing mask is mandatory on the college premises.
13. It is also mandatory for every student to maintain the protocol of physical distancing.

7. ₹ 25/- will be charged on the damage of Bar Code.
8. If books are not returned within given period, the student will be charged ₹ 1/- per day for each book.

FACILITIES

- 1. The Botanical Garden :** The college has developed an independent and beautiful botanical garden. Various plants of rare types have been planted in the garden. It is very much instrumental in providing practical teaching-learning atmosphere.

These aids are very useful in making the teaching more effective and meaningful.
- 3. The Laboratories :** The Departments of Chemistry, Physics, Botany, Computer Science and Zoology have their own independent well-equipped and advanced laboratories. Equipments and chemicals required for the students of UG and PG classes are available in the laboratories.
- 4. The Literary Associations :** Various Literary Associations have been established with an objective of achieving deep knowledge of these subjects. These associations organize various lectures, workshops and departmental seminars.
- 5. The Science Association :** In the era of information technology and scientific temper, the study of fundamental sciences have become very significant. The association organizes various activities, educational trips etc. These activities are intended to make the teaching learning process more lively and meaningful.
- 6. The Commerce Association :** The association works with an objective of making the teaching and learning of commerce more practical, relevant and comprehensive. The association organizes lectures of the scholars, workshops, seminars, exhibitions, educational trips and commerce festival.
- 7. The Vidyarthini Manch :** Special activities for girls' students are organized through the formation of a platform named "The Vidyarthini Manch" with a woman professor in charge of it. The emphasis has been on things and issues relevant to girls in particular. As it is the part and parcel of our mission, the focus of interest is to make the girl self-reliant. The Manch organizes invited lectures too.
- 8. Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University Study Centre :** The centre has started BA and BCom courses with a view of providing education to the unprivileged girls, boys and elders. A student aged 18 without SSC or HSC (The student has to pass preparatory examination) is eligible to seek admission for the course if he/she pass the pre-admission test. The MCom course of YCMOU also has been started from the session 2019-2020.
- 9. National Service Scheme (NSS) :** The college has a NSS unit. The student enthusiastic about social work, are provided a platform through NSS. The actual enrolment however depends upon the University guidelines.
- 10. National Cadet Corps (NCC) :** The college has a separate NCC Unit for boys (50 cadets) and girls. All expenses on uniforms, kit, annual training etc. are borne by the Government. Students are encouraged to join NCC where they get Military Training which enables them to join the army.
- 11. Students' Welfare :** Under this scheme, economically backward students are

allowed to do certain tasks in various departments of the college and the college garden and are given remuneration to aid them financially.

12. Alumni Association : College Alumni Association has been registered. There are 11 members in the association. The association is actively involved in different academic and non-academic programmes.

13. Students' Council : The students' council is formed in accordance with the provisions of Maharashtra University Act 2016. One of the teacher is designated as a working Chairman. The Principal is the Ex-officio Chairman of the Students' Council. One of the students of the college is elected / nominated as the General Secretary.

14. Group Insurance Cover for Students : The college is introducing a Group Insurance for the students of the college. The risk cover includes death, loss of limbs, total / Partial / Permanent disablement.

15. Soft Skill Development Programme : The Programme of Personality Development in the era of LPG(Liberlization,Privatization and Globalization) has great importance. The students from rural sector may not compete without this various soft skills are imparted to the students through this programme which is very enriching.

16. Placement Cell : The Career guidance and counseling is arranged and students are provided placement opportunities through this cell. Various companies are invited for the campus interview.

17. Sports : Training and required facilities are provided to the students playing outdoor games viz-Cricket, Volley Ball, Khokho, Kabaddi, Athletics and Indoor games like Mat Wrestling, Yoga, Badminton, Chess etc.

18. Library : Library is the soul of the college. The main attraction of an academic community and the students is the college library. Various text books, reference books, encyclopedia, journals, magazines, newspapers, newspaper clipping are made available to the students.

19. Facilities Available in Library : Reading Room, Book Bank , Internet and N-List Facility.

20. Digital Platform Facility : This is a platform where from Student access their educational and learning material in digital formats like audio, video and online meetings.
